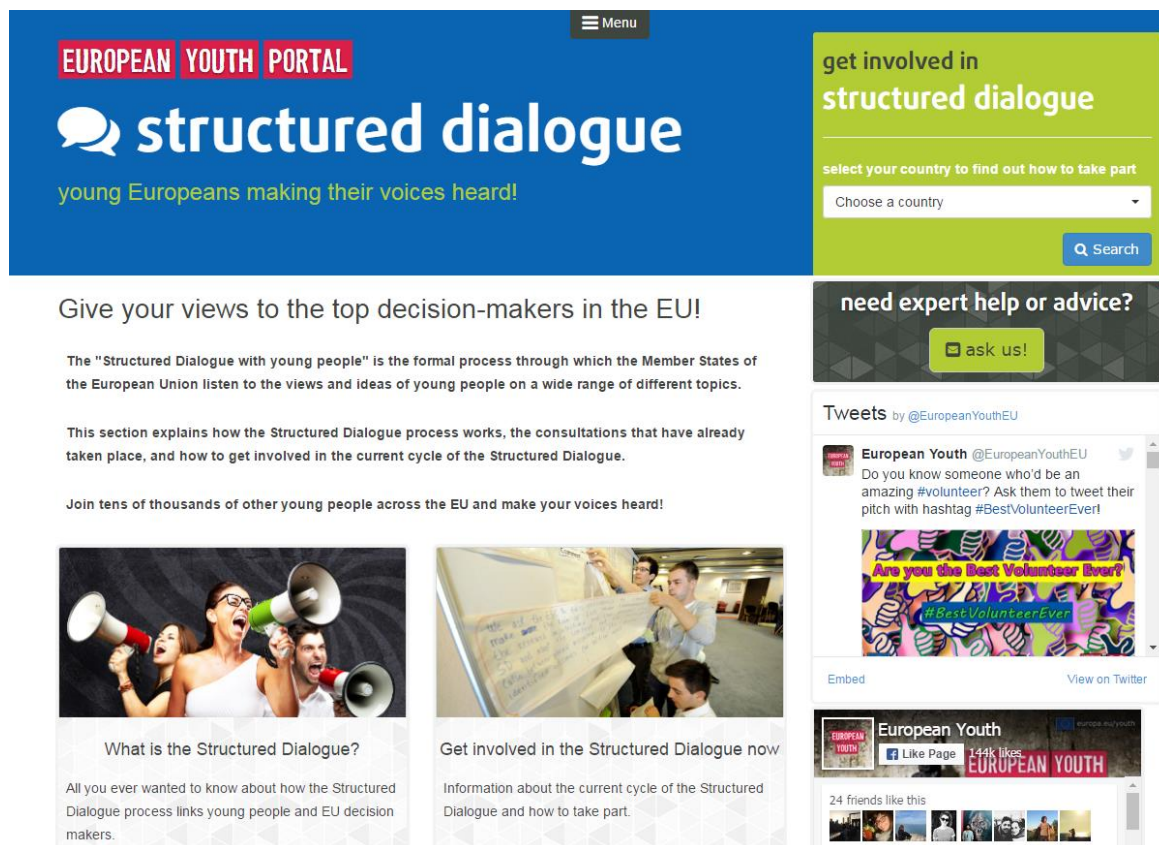

The EU Youth Monitor is based on the EU Youth Dashboard  , composed of 41 indicators covering all eight fields of action of the EU Youth Strategy.

It is updated regularly, on the basis of data provided by Eurostat or Eurobarometer surveys.

The Monitor provides information from 2010 onwards, where available.

**** VI Ciclo di DS (2016 - 6.17): in Italia hanno partecipato 500 giovani su 8.500.000**

The most mentioned priority topics that young people want the EU to focus on are:

- Education and skills (53%)
- Protection of the environment and the fight against climate change (50%)
- Employment (42%)
- The management of migration and integration of refugees (40%)

31% of young people say they have been involved in **organised voluntary activities** in the last twelve months.

A majority of young people (64%) say they have voted in at least one political election over the last three years.



5.2018 Situation of young people in the European Union

Per una nuova strategia Europea 2019-2027

Main findings:

- Young people are **educated to an increasingly higher level**
- More young people are **finding employment**. Around 1.3 million fewer jobless young people live in the EU today compared to 2013 (In Italia: 32% - In Euro Area: 16.8%).
- There has been some **improvement in the social inclusion** of young Europeans (NEETs in Italia: 29,5% - In EU: 17.2%).
- Young people appear **less prone to risky health behaviors**.
- Young Europeans are demonstrating an **increasing interest in politics** and are taking advantage of the **new methods of participation** offered by modern technology (Ma la partecipazione dei giovani a processi elettorali continua a diminuire in tutta EU).
- **Participation in voluntary activities** shows an exceptional expansion

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5.2018 European Commission:

Engaging, Connecting and Empowering young people: a new EU Youth Strategy

ENGAGE: Fostering young people's **participation** in civic and democratic life.

CONNECT: Connecting young people across the European Union and beyond to foster **voluntary engagement**, learning mobility, solidarity and intercultural understanding.

EMPOWER: Supporting youth empowerment through **quality, innovation and recognition** of youth work.

The strategy will pay special attention to:

- **Reaching out to all young people:** youth with fewer opportunities are 36% of the beneficiaries;
- **From global to local:** EU youth cooperation should better connect with local and regional levels;
- **... and the virtual world:** equipping youth with digital skills and critical thinking.
